It is estimated that 100,000 churches will close by 2050. I believe that might be an underestimation. Churches that forty years ago were vibrant and growing are filled with the same people from forty years ago and dying. Many of these churches thought that they would "hire" someone who would make the church grow. They went through one preacher after another, one youth minister after another while continuing to slide in attendance. Many of members can't remember when someone was baptized. Less than ten people a year visit. Most never come back. People aren't looking for a dying church. These churches have lost the manifest presence of God. In fact, His manifest presence has been gone so long they can't remember how to recognize it.

Why didn't the churches continue to grow? It wasn't something they did. It was something they neglected to do. They failed to ask God for fruit. Yes, they prayed but their prayers were for the sick and dying only. They have no new life in the church because they failed to ask for new life. They spent more time criticizing the staff and pastor for not meeting their needs than praying that they would reach new people. They lost the majesty of God because they simply came to church without crying out for Him to work in themselves and others. They see no miracles because they don't believe in them enough to ask God for them.

Is it over, then? It doesn't have to be. Prayer is something that costs nothing and everything at the same time. People could be praying for their churches. They can even be shut-ins that can't make it to the building. However, these prayers can't simply be for the sick and dying. They must be for spiritual health and living. They must be for fruit.

Would you be one of those that prays for more baptisms because we are reaching people with the gospel? Would you pray that a new fire is stirred up in the church so that the members see the manifest presence of God? Would you be one who genuinely prays beyond the walls of the church building?

I am convinced that the need for prayer in our church is so great that the failure to do so will mean that Thalia Lynn will be one of those 100,000 churches closing her doors by 2050. Don't you want the church to live on after you are gone?

The XP Corner: Church Growth Comes through Prayer

The Bible does not specifically address church growth, but the principle of church growth is the understanding that Jesus said, "I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it" (Matthew 16:18). Paul confirmed that the church has its foundation in Jesus Christ (1 Corinthians 3:11). Jesus Christ is also the head of the church (Ephesians 1:18-23) and the church's life (John 10:10). It should be remembered that there are different kinds of "growth", many of which have nothing to do with numbers.

A church can be alive and growing even though the number of members/attendees is not changing. If those in the church are growing in the grace and knowledge of the Lord Jesus, submitting to His will for their lives, both individually and corporately, that is a church that is experiencing true growth. Likewise, a church can be adding to its rolls weekly, have huge numbers, and still be spiritually stagnant.

Growth of any kind follows a typical pattern. As with a growing organism, the local church has those who plant the seed, those who water the seed, and others who use their spiritual gifts for the growth of those in the local church. But note that it is God who gives the increase (1 Corinthians 3:7). Those who plant and those who water will each receive their own reward according to their labor (1 Corinthians 3:8).

There must be a balance between planting and watering for a local church to grow, which means that in a healthy church each person must know what his/her spiritual gift is so that he/she can best function within the body of Christ. Above all, there must be daily dependence upon and obedience to the Holy Spirit so His power can be released in those who plant and water for God's increase to come. This power comes only through prayer and supplication.

The description of a living and growing church is found in Acts 2:42-47 where the believers "devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer." They were alive and on mission. They were serving one another and reaching out to those who needed to know the Lord, for the Lord "added to their number daily those who were being saved." When these things are present, the church will experience spiritual growth, and even a numerical increase.


Centrikid offers overnight camps for 2nd-6th graders to experience the time of their lives and learn more about the message of Jesus Christ!


