

# Sermon NOTES



## The Resurrection of the Saints

- 1) Romans 8:28 (ESV) <sup>28</sup> And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.
- 2) Matthew 27:50-54 (ESV) <sup>50</sup> And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice and yielded up his spirit. <sup>51</sup> And behold, the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. And the earth shook, and the rocks were split. <sup>52</sup> The tombs also were opened. And many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised, <sup>53</sup> and coming out of the tombs after his resurrection they went into the holy city and appeared to many. <sup>54</sup> When the centurion and those who were with him, keeping watch over Jesus, saw the earthquake and what took place, they were filled with awe and said, "Truly this was the Son of God!"
- 3) Just when you think that God has lost control, He comes through.

- 11) Isaiah 24:18 (ESV) <sup>18</sup> He who flees at the sound of the terror shall fall into the pit, and he who climbs out of the pit shall be caught in the snare. For the windows of heaven are opened, and the foundations of the earth tremble.
- 12) Joel 2:10 (ESV) <sup>10</sup> The earth quakes before them; the heavens tremble. The sun and the moon are darkened, and the stars withdraw their shining.
- 13) Nahum 1:5-6 (ESV) <sup>5</sup> The mountains quake before him; the hills melt; the earth heaves before him, the world and all who dwell in it. <sup>6</sup> Who can stand before his indignation? Who can endure the heat of his anger? His wrath is poured out like fire, and the rocks are broken into pieces by him.
- 14) Matthew 24:3-33 (ESV)
