## Resurrection Sunday

1) Mark 16:1–8 (NASB 2020) <sup>1</sup> When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might come and anoint Him. <sup>2</sup> And very early on the first day of the week, they came to the tomb when the sun had risen. <sup>3</sup> They were saying to one another, “Who will roll away the stone from the entrance of the tomb for us?” <sup>4</sup> And looking up, they noticed that the stone had been rolled away; for it was extremely large. <sup>5</sup> And entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting at the right, wearing a white robe; and they were amazed. <sup>6</sup> But he said to them, “Do not be amazed; you are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who has been crucified. He has risen; He is not here; see, here is the place where they laid Him. <sup>7</sup> But go, tell His disciples and Peter, ‘He is going ahead of you to Galilee; there you will see Him, just as He told you.’ ” <sup>8</sup> And they went out and fled from the tomb, for trembling and astonishment had gripped them; and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid.

- 9) Matthew 26:73–74 (NASB 2020)<sup>73</sup> A little later the bystanders came up and said to Peter, “You really are one of them as well, since even the way you talk gives you away.”<sup>74</sup> Then he began to curse and swear, “I do not know the man!” And immediately a rooster crowed.
