

# The Fullness of the Blessing

## Romans 15:28-29

1. Jeremiah 29:11 (ESV) <sup>11</sup> For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope.
2. Romans 15:28-29 (ESV) <sup>28</sup> When therefore I have completed this and have delivered to them what has been collected, I will leave for Spain by way of you. <sup>29</sup> I know that when I come to you I will come in the fullness of the blessing of Christ.
3. We can only receive the fullness of the blessing when we are \_\_\_\_\_the will of our Lord.
4. Deuteronomy 11:26-27 (ESV) <sup>26</sup> “See, I am setting before you today a blessing and a curse: <sup>27</sup> the blessing, if you obey the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you today,
5. Dallas Willard, the Dean of Philosophy at USC for many years said: “How could there be a personal relationship, a personal walk with God—or anyone else—without individualized communication? (Hearing God, p. 22)
6. You receive a \_\_\_\_\_from God.
7. This may come from the Word of God, the \_\_\_\_\_.
8. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 (ESV) <sup>16</sup> All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, <sup>17</sup> that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.
9. Since God does not make mistakes, no other word that you believe came from God will \_\_\_\_\_the Scriptures.
10. Understanding God’s word as it is intended comes through the explanation of the \_\_\_\_\_.
11. 1 Corinthians 2:14 (ESV) <sup>14</sup> The natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned.
12. 2 Kings 22:11 (ESV) <sup>11</sup> When the king heard the words of the Book of the Law, he tore his clothes.
13. Matthew 6:31-33 (ESV) <sup>31</sup> Therefore do not be anxious, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’ <sup>32</sup> For the Gentiles seek after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them all. <sup>33</sup> But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

14. A word from God may come through the \_\_\_\_\_.
15. 2 Chronicles 20:14-15 (ESV) <sup>14</sup> And the Spirit of the LORD came upon Jahaziel the son of Zechariah, son of Benaiah, son of Jeiel, son of Mattaniah, a Levite of the sons of Asaph, in the midst of the assembly. <sup>15</sup> And he said, "Listen, all Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem and King Jehoshaphat: Thus says the LORD to you, 'Do not be afraid and do not be dismayed at this great horde, for the battle is not yours but God's.
16. A word from God may come through other \_\_\_\_\_ people.
17. 1 Thessalonians 2:13 (ESV) <sup>13</sup> And we also thank God constantly for this, that when you received the word of God, which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men but as what it really is, the word of God, which is at work in you believers.
18. The word of God may come through \_\_\_\_\_.
19. Romans 1:19 (ESV) <sup>19</sup> For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them.
20. Our obedience to the values of the world will \_\_\_\_\_ our hearing.
21. 1 John 2:15-16 (ESV) <sup>15</sup> Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. <sup>16</sup> For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life—is not from the Father but is from the world.
22. Hebrews 5:11 (ESV) <sup>11</sup> About this we have much to say, and it is hard to explain, since you have become dull of hearing.
23. 1 Samuel 28:6 (ESV) <sup>6</sup> And when Saul inquired of the LORD, the LORD did not answer him, either by dreams, or by Urim, or by prophets.
24. 1 Samuel 28:7 (ESV) <sup>7</sup> Then Saul said to his servants, "Seek out for me a woman who is a medium, that I may go to her and inquire of her." And his servants said to him, "Behold, there is a medium at Endor."
25. A renewed mind is necessary to see the will of God \_\_\_\_\_ the values of the world.
26. Romans 12:2 (ESV) <sup>2</sup> Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.
27. Set your mind on the \_\_\_\_\_.
28. Romans 8:5 (ESV) <sup>5</sup> For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit.
29. James 1:23-25 (ESV) <sup>23</sup> For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks

intently at his natural face in a mirror. <sup>24</sup> For he looks at himself and goes away and at once forgets what he was like. <sup>25</sup> But the one who looks into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and perseveres, being no hearer who forgets but a doer who acts, he will be blessed in his doing.

30. Take every thought \_\_\_\_\_.
31. 2 Corinthians 10:5 (ESV) <sup>5</sup> We destroy arguments and every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ,
32. Make discernment \_\_\_\_\_.
33. Hebrews 5:14 (ESV) <sup>14</sup> But solid food is for the mature, for those who have their powers of discernment trained by constant practice to distinguish good from evil.
34. \_\_\_\_\_often.
35. John 10:27 (ESV) <sup>27</sup> My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me.
36. Romans 1:17 (ESV) <sup>17</sup> For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."
